



At Roxburgh Homestead Primary School, we are SUPER excited to be introducing and using Seesaw with our Foundation (Prep) to Year 2 students in 2020. Seesaw empowers students to independently document their learning using built-in tools, and provides an authentic audience for their work. Seesaw gives students a place to communicate an understanding of their learning, be creative and learn how to use technology in a safe online environment.

How does Seesaw work?

Each student will have their own journal set up in their 'Class' and they will be able to add things to it, like photos, videos, drawings, or notes. Students and Home Tutors can import directly from popular apps, like Google apps and Pic Collage, into Seesaw.

Seesaw allows us to share a range of files (jpg, png, mov, mp4, pdf, etc) that may be larger than our emails would allow. This will be of enormous benefit for assessments, feedback, support and send-in tasks.

How do I access Seesaw?

1. On a computer (must be using a Chrome or Firefox browser) or Chromebook at <https://web.seesaw.me>
2. iOS device (iPad, iPhone) by downloading the Seesaw 'Class' app.
3. Kindle Fire by downloading the Seesaw 'Class' app.



What happens now?

This year the teachers at RHPS will be trialing and implementing Seesaw at different times. Once your student's class/es have been set up, you will be notified by the teacher/s. Students will use their school MIS email address to log into their 'Class'. All students require an updated Third Party Consent form signed by their parent/guardian before using Seesaw.

What about the families?

Once your student has been added to a class, the teacher will also send you an invitation which will allow families to follow their student's work in their Seesaw classroom. You'll be able to see posts in their journal, be notified about new posts and receive announcements from teachers.
